Established in 2000, Trinity Catholic High School has educated more than 2,000 alumni and has a current enrollment of 500 students. Trinity Catholic has established a young tradition of delivering academic excellence while fostering faith formation in all it does. To remain the college preparatory school the community looks to for outstanding and well-rounded graduates, we continue to improve and expand our curriculum and provide state-of-the-art facilities for our students.

There is a thriving fine arts program at Trinity Catholic. This year we have 60 students participating in band, 55 in choir and many more actively involved in art and theater. Many of these students have been recognized for excellence at All-State competitions, yet we do not have an appropriate space for them to perform or display their work. Currently, school concerts, plays, assemblies and all-school Masses are held in the gym or cafeteria.

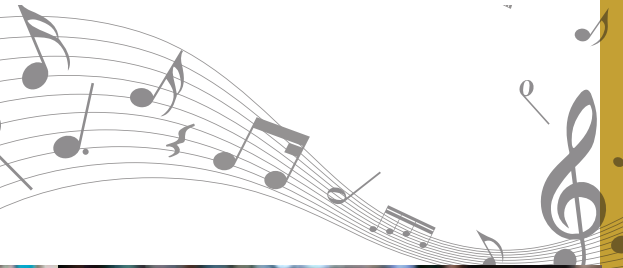


The Reflecting God's Glory Together Campaign goal is \$12 million for the construction of the Colangelo Fine Arts Center.

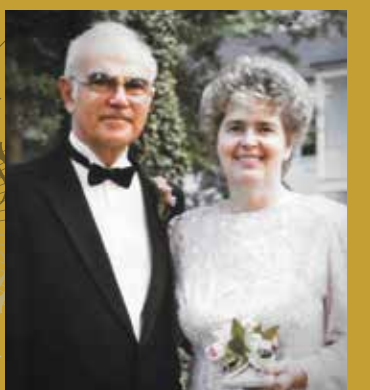

Gifts received beyond the campaign goal will provide an endowment to support long term maintenance of the performing arts and visual arts center at Trinity Catholic



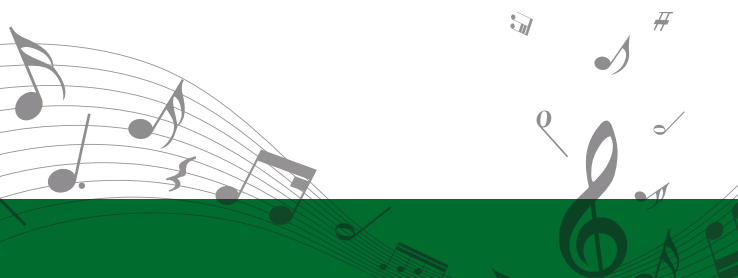

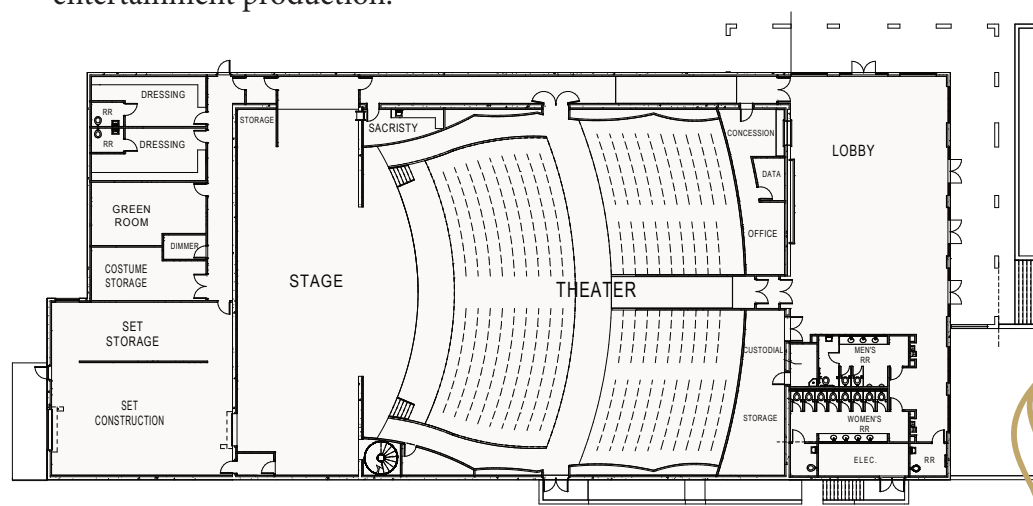
