Step 1. Organize your resources for sharing your message.

Volunteer recruitment announcement for newsletters and bulletins:

How to share the message of Catholic Giving Tuesday?

Here are some examples:

- Share a social media post with note as simple as "Friends and family please join me in supporting us this Catholic Giving Tuesday! Every gift makes an impact on this important day of Catholic charity. Here is the link: <u>https://www.cfocf.org/catholicgivingtuesday/</u>
- Send out some text messages to your contact list "Hi NAME, will you consider making a gift to (name of organization) for Catholic Giving Tuesday? It really makes a difference! I already made mine. Here is the link, it only takes a minute: <u>https://www.cfocf.org/catholicgivingtuesday/</u>
- Send an email to your contacts "Hi everyone, I just made my gift to (name of organization) for Catholic Giving Tuesday. Will you make a donation as well? Step 4: Begin Sending your communications.

Interested in creating your own custom email message? Here is a recommended template:

First line(s): Thank your audience for their continued support/participation in your organization.

Second line(s): Let your audience know that Catholic Giving Tuesday is approaching.

<u>Third lines(s)</u>: Remind your audience of what their gift on Catholic Giving Tuesday will help accomplish for your organization. This is a great time to incorporate a quote or story!

<u>Fourth line(s)</u>: remind your audience to make their gift online on or before November 28th. Don't forget the link!

Fifth line(s): Thank your audience and wish them well.
