OUR NEED

Our goal is to raise \$3.2 million to refresh our spiritual home and continue to be "A Welcoming Community of Believers."



A beautiful, inspiring church forms us in the celebration of the memorial of the Lord's Passion and Resurrection. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the heart of our life in Christ. Our church building, however, has seen little interior work since its expansion in 1996. With the wear and tear of nearly thirty years' constant use, our church needs attention to keep it worthy of worship. The cleaning protocols of the pandemic took a toll on the pew surfaces. The sound system has dead spots in the church which especially affect our hearing-impaired members. The paint and carpeting are worn. The house of the Lord should evoke awe and wonder before his glory.

We have benefitted from the sacrifice of generations who have gone before us. Now it is our turn to continue the legacy and renew the spiritual home for generations to come. For most, the church building is where our experience of the church begins. Younger generations are attracted by technology such as high-definition video screens that help them participate in the Mass. They appreciate bathrooms with handicap facilities for aging parents and extra space for young children. For themselves, they want to get to know people and make true friends in faith. They crave the peace and reverence that an online-only life lacks. A beautiful and inviting church welcomes all to move from saying, "I go to Nativity," to saying, "I belong to Nativity." It forms us into disciples who make disciples.

OUR PLAN

Expand Welcoming Entrance

Greet guests with a permanent welcome desk and a larger, more accessible church gift shop.

Upgrade Restroom Facilities

Relocate and expand the restroom facilities to be handicap accessible, with automatic door openers for the mobility impaired. Add a large family restroom.

Install New Stained-Glass Windows

Cover the clear windows along the side walls with stained-glass windows.













Relocate the Crucifix in the Sanctuary

Move the large crucifix from the side wall and hang it above the altar. Install ambient lighting directly above the altar.

Revitalize the Nave

Repaint the walls in the nave. Renew the faded woodwork. Relocate the Stations of the Cross from the back wall to the pillars to make them more visible. Update the fire system and fire extinguishers.

Enhance Audio/Video Technology

Upgrade the sound system to include better accessibility for the hearing-impaired and improved sound quality for the choir and musicians. Relocate the speaker boxes currently above the altar area. Install high-definition video monitors to aid participation in the liturgy. Replace the deteriorating organ. Expand the media control room. Install additional audio ports in the church entrance for special outdoor activities.

Replace Carpeting and Restore Pews

Replace the worn carpeting in the nave with an updated color pattern. Reupholster the pews with a complementary fabric. Replace the worn altar carpet with a vibrant tile surface.



Renew the Main Entrance

Gather in the narthex (main church entrance) with new flooring and acoustic panels for improved sound quality. An open gallery will extend all the way to the chapel, with religious icons on the wall and glass windows for a clear view into the nave (main body of the church).

Replace Old Mechanical Items

These include 30-year-old HVAC units, Fire Panels, lighting system and dimmer controls.

Create a Multi-purpose Space

Convert the current overflow room into a multi-purpose space with soundproofing and a large glass viewing window into the nave. Use it for a cry room, meeting space, choir rehearsal, and future needs.

Serve Others

Tithe 10% of the collected campaign funds to another parish in need.
