

This restructuring will maintain the talented teams that have been serving pastors, parishes, schools, and donors since 2008. The community services, data, and accounting team members who have served as the trusted contractors of the Diocese of Orlando at The Catholic Foundation will continue to support donors with contributions to Our Catholic Appeal, Shepherd's Fund, and capital campaigns within the new Discipleship and Stewardship Office. Additionally, the Foundation's donor services and administration team will continue to serve donors with philanthropic advisory services, endowments, donor designated funds, and donor advised funds, as well as assisting donors with planned and estate gifts for Catholic ministries.

Please be assured that no financial assets will be transferred from the Foundation to the Diocese during this restructuring. 


# Meet The New Members of Our Planned Giving Advisory Council


