## **CAP® OVERVIEW**

The Catholic Foundation, Rollins College, 55 North Private Wealth, and ShuffieldLowman, with the support of Edyth Bush Charitable Foundation, are collaborating to do more in our community through philanthropy. We are co-hosting study groups designed to bring together client-facing advisors and non-profit executives to earn the Chartered in Philanthropy (CAP®) designation provided by The American College of Financial Services. This designation signifies that the student has successfully passed exams for the three graduate-level courses:

- GS839: Planning for Philanthropic Impact in the Context of Family Wealth
- GS849: Charitable Giving Strategies
- GS859: Gift Planning in a Non-Profit Context

## STUDY GROUP

The study group will engage multi-sector professionals who support members of our community with decisions for charitable giving. There are 9 meetings with a graduation event over a ninemonth period. Participants must commit to attending a minimum of 60% of the sessions. Most students indicate they study about three to four hours in preparation for every one hour spent in the classroom. Class size is limited to facilitate lively interactions among participants. Participants are selected based on their area of expertise and the experience they bring to the study group. These sessions will enhance learning specifically about our region and our donors with an exchange of ideas and opportunities to meet donors and expert speakers.
