2. Revocable living trust
 List all personal property and decide which people/charities you want to receive each asset Transfer your personal property into the trust Name a successor trustee to manage your trust after you pass away
4. Advance healthcare directive
 Outline your medical care preferences in your living will Name a healthcare agent to make important medical decisions for you in your medical power of attorney
6. Insurance policies / finance info
 Gather copies of your life, health, car, and home insurance policy documents Create a list of your financial accounts and institutions (e.g., bank accounts, credit cards, mortgages, loans)
8. Titles and property deeds
 □ Gather the titles and deeds for your homes, vehicles, and real estate. Confirm the listed owner is correct. □ If you've established a trust, retitle your property so the trust is the owner.
10. Funeral instructions
Create a list of your funeral preferences: Burial, cremation, etc. What type of service you'd prefer Passages you want read Preferred charities for donations Whether or not you prefer flowers
